My Career Interests

Introduction

Exploring career interests helps students identify paths that align with their passions, skills, and values. In this lesson, participants will examine opportunities that inspire them, develop their strengths, and connect personal goals to meaningful career choices.

SET UP

Review lesson materials and determine which worksheets and handouts you will use for the lesson. Print enough pre/post assessments, worksheets, and handouts for each participant.

ACTIVITY

- 1. Have participants complete the *Pre-assessment*.
- 2. Begin with a group discussion: Why do people choose different careers? What factors influence these choices? *(Optional video opener: "How to Choose the Right Career Path in 7 Simple Steps" 4:05 see link in the Resources section)

Supplies

- Worksheets
- Handouts
- Pens/Pencils

OUTCOMES

Students will be able to:

- Set short- and long-term goals for career exploration.
- Demonstrate leadership and collaboration by sharing findings and ideas with peers.
- Identify personal interests, strengths, and values for career decision-making.
- Connect career paths to purpose and community impact.
- Compare careers within top interest clusters and evaluate how well they match personal goals.
- 4. Distribute *My Dream Job.* Instruct participants to complete **only** Part 1. Prompt: *Write down your dream job. Be honest, even if you are unsure.*
- 5. Distribute the *Career Clusters Interest Survey*. Read the instructions as a group and guide participants through completion.
- 6. Distribute the *Career Clusters Descriptions* handout. Participants should read their top 3 clusters and highlight options that stand out. If time allows, participants should use the *Reflection Section* to learn more about careers in their top clusters.
- 7. Instruct participants to return to the *My Dream Job* handout and complete *Part 2: A New Career Idea I Discovered* and compare it with their original idea.

- 8. Group students in pairs or small groups. Facilitate group discussions with these prompts:
 - Q. How did your ideas shift after completing the survey?
 - Q. What surprised you most?
 - Q. Did you confirm your original dream job or discover new career paths?
- 9. *Exit Ticket* depending on time, this can be done as a class discussion, or students can complete the worksheet in class, as homework, or in the following class.
- 10. Have participants complete *Post-assessment*.
